7. Covered bike shelter – Simon has spoken to Simon H providing £5k, Shanklin Street are forming a bike shelter community group to manage and council to review the space – great progress so far and support from the council.
8. Parking review – worth commenting on in regards to bike parking, green infrastructure and dropped curbs.
9. Finance – Thank you Lesley for reviewing and finalising last year's accounts. All checked accounts and agreed.
10. Climate emergency – Responses from candidates have been shared with elected members – Nancy Platts has responded positively.
